

Identify the tabs in accordance with the parts under Section 3, which is to be consistent with the Table of Contents. TAB IDENTIFICATION BY NUMBERS ONLY IS NOT ACCEPTABLE.





#### PROJECT APPROACH

In keeping with the definition of a **State Natural Area**, the trail development footprint is a small percentage of the total acreage on the site. Within that development footprint, the design intent for all trail construction is to *minimize impact to the resource*.

This can generally be described as being "light on the land," or having a "minimal footprint," relative to city or county park trail systems.

The Professional Trail Builders Association (PTBA) is considered the primary trade association for the trail industry for contractors, designers, and consultants. PTBA represents the leading edge in sustainable trail development and maintenance.

The Contractor (or subcontracted firm) must be **certified by the PTBA** and demonstrate **at least five years' experience in trail design and mechanized trail construction.** 

In addition, the design and construction must follow **all guidelines established by TPWD resource coordinators** to best protect the natural and cultural resources of the SNA, including archeological sites and/or rare species habitat.

#### 2.02 SCOPE OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

The phases for professional services include Construction Documents, Construction Administration and Warranty performance. Professional services required could include, but are not limited to the following:

- Additional Geotechnical investigation as determined by the Design-Builder team (preliminary geotechnical investigations have been performed in multiple locations on site and those reports are included in the Design Criteria Manual appendices)
- · Additional ground topographical surveying as determined by the Design-Builder team
  - An AutoCAD file of ground survey information acquired to date will be provided at Step 2.
  - The entirety of the ABK SNA boundary was flown on 9/2/22 and LiDAR processing AutoCAD files of 1' contours, as well as ortho photogrammetry will be made available to the awarded Contractor.
- Civil Engineering
- Architecture
- Landscape Architecture
- · Structural Engineering
- Registered Accessibility Specialist plan review and inspections, including Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) registration and fees
- Cost Estimating
