General Information:

- 1. Each applicant offer for the license buyback within each individual application period will be ranked against all other applicant offers within that application period. Funds permitting the Department will hold at least one application period per license year.
- 2. The ranking will consider applicant bid amount and several other factors such as: length of vessel, duration holding the license, amount of money in the buyback fund, number of total licenses in the bay and bait fishery, number of licenses being offered by the individual for a vessel, and bid offers from previous application periods, may be considered in the ranking.
- 3. **ALSO**, a maximum amount that the department can pay for each individual license will be established using the criteria in Number 2 (above). If your bid is greater than this maximum amount your bid will be rejected during this application period, but can be considered in future application periods.
- 4. The department will attempt to contact each applicant within 21 days of the end of the application period to indicate acceptance or rejection of the bid. If accepted you will have 15 days from the date of the acceptance letter to notify the department that you intend to sign a contract and set up a time to make the license transfer.
- 5. Department records will be used to verify all information supplied by or pertaining to the applicant's history in the shrimp fishery. By submitting this application, you are certifying that you were eligible to purchase the license that you are offering to sell.
- 6. Your individual bid information on this application will remain confidential.
- 7. You must fill out all application blanks to be considered for that application period.
- 8. If you are only offering a particular license (only a bay or only a bait), please ignore the blanks that do not apply to that particular license number and bid offer on the application.
- 9. All applications must be received at the address listed on the back of your application and postmarked prior to the application deadline. The application deadline is <u>January 31, 2016</u>. To ensure your application is received by the Department, you may consider using Certified Mail.
- 10. You must provide copies of documentation that indicates you are the sole owner of the vessel for which you are offering the license from. If you represent a partnership or corporation that holds the license, you are responsible to obtain legal documentation from all members of the partnership or the management of the corporation indicating they are in agreement with the License Buyback Bid Offer. **This is solely your responsibility and must be completed before the application can be considered.**
- 11. Please **send only copies** of any licenses, proof of ownership documents, or special documents proving your history in the commercial bait and bay fishery.
- 12. If you are submitting licenses from more than one vessel, please fill out a separate application for each different vessel.
- 13. Payment for any prior monies owed the department will be paid in full prior to completing a buyback transaction with the Department. Payment for any prior monies or liens owed to the state or the Attorney General's office will be seized in full prior to the applicant receiving any remaining balance.
