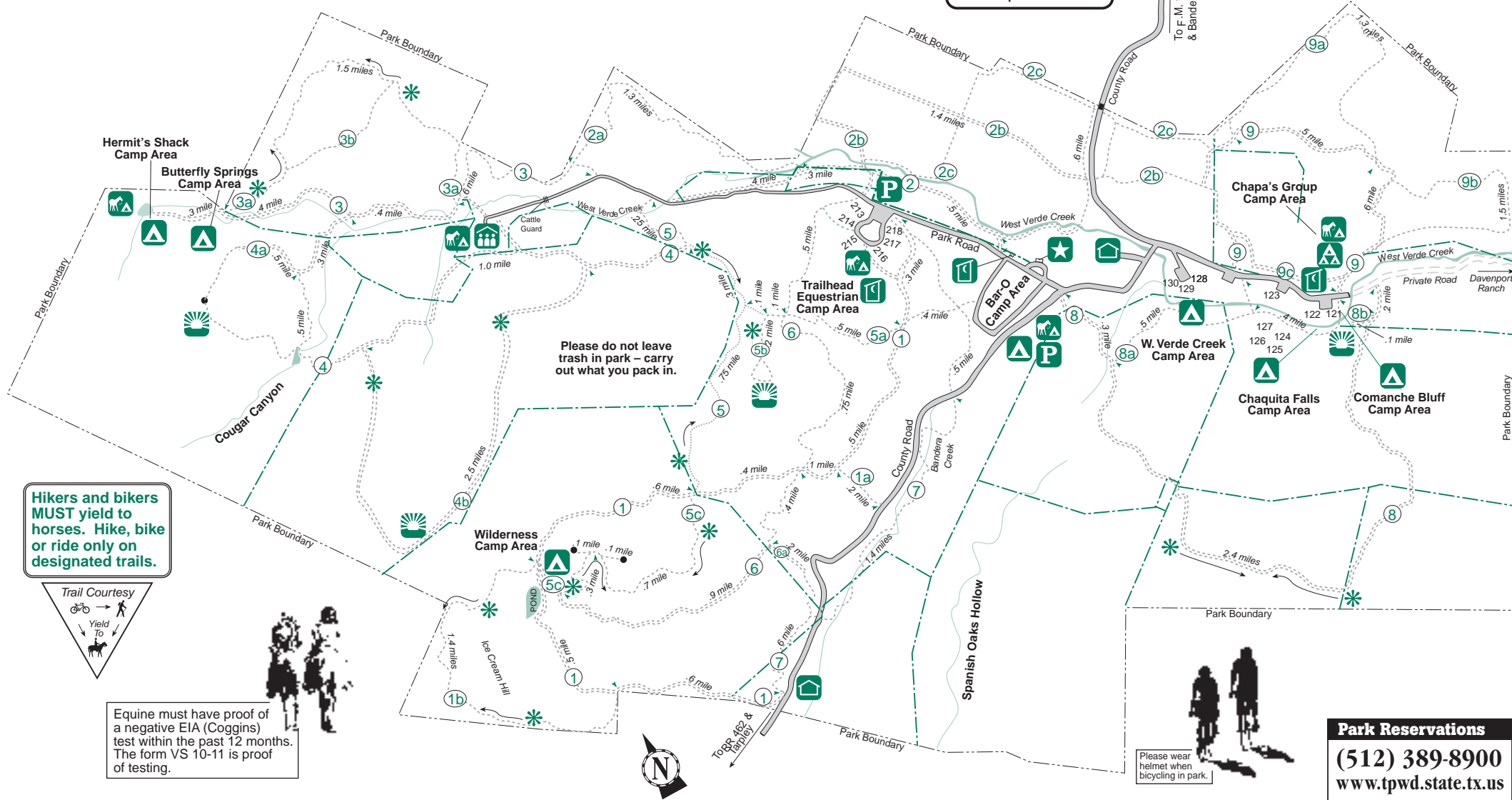

# Hill Country

## State Natural Area

It is illegal to disturb, collect or remove fossils, artifacts, plants or animals from public lands.



Please do not leave trash in park – carry out what you pack in.

Hikers and bikers MUST yield to horses. Hike, bike or ride only on designated trails.



Equine must have proof of a negative EIA (Coggins) test within the past 12 months. The form VS 10-11 is proof of testing.

Please wear helmet when bicycling in park.
